

# MAKE YOUR HOME MORE ACCESSIBLE

WITH THE ACCESSIBILITY MODIFICATION PROGRAM (AMP)

## 2023 GRANT INFORMATION

Homeowners that meet this program's requirements can receive up to \$10,000 in funding through the Accessibility Modification Program (AMP) to make eligible repairs and modifications to their homes to make it more accessible.



## WHAT REPAIRS ARE ELIGIBLE?

This is a complete list of eligible repairs. If the repair you need is not on this list, it does not qualify for the program.

- Ramps/zero step entries
- Handrails
- Levered door handles
- Self-closing hinges (internal/external doors)
- Pocket doors or swing hinges
- Internal chair and wheelchair lifts
- Plumbing and electrical modifications necessary to relocate laundry facilities to the main level of the home
- Home modification assessment expenses up to \$250, when performed by a certified professional
- Widened doorways
- Installation of smoke detectors or carbon monoxide detectors
- Universal Design flooring
- Bathroom modifications
  - Walk-in/roll-in showers
  - Grab bars
  - Rebath - easy entry bath
  - ADA-approved toilets/drop down grab bar
  - Roll-under vanity
  - Lower level ½ bath conversions to eliminate need to go upstairs

# ARE YOU A QUALIFIED HOMEOWNER?

TO QUALIFY FOR AN AMP GRANT, YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS.

## INCOME REQUIREMENTS:

- Your gross household income must be at or below 80% Area Median Income (AMI).

## HOMEOWNER REQUIREMENTS

- All household members are age 62 or older; or
- All household members are age 62 or older and age 17 or younger where the household member age 62 or older is the guardian of the younger household members; or
- A household member of any age has a permanent disability
- You must obtain a bid from two (2) independent contractors.
- You must provide all requested income and other documentation.

## PROPERTY REQUIREMENTS:

- All persons listed on the deed must live in the home (except for a child for estate planning purposes),
- Your home must be located in Indiana or Michigan,
- You must have lived in the home for at least six (6) months prior to applying for AMP,
- Your mortgage and property taxes must be paid as agreed and current, and
- Your home is a single-family home, condominium, duplex, or manufactured home with certain restrictions
